Procuring (2) tents and two different sizes will allow CERT members to provide shelter for any type of event or incident in the city. In addition, procure (2) mobile coolers to attach to the tents thus making these tents mobile cooling centers. These mobile cooling centers are important for the city to have in an effort to provide safe, secure and comfortable relief from extreme heat, high winds and hazardous environments.
