

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-007

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FONTANA,
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY STORM DRAIN REPAIR
WORK ON VALLEY BOULEVARD AT HEMLOCK AVENUE AND ELM
AVENUE.**

WHEREAS, an unsafe condition has been determined to exist on Valley Boulevard at Hemlock Avenue and Elm Avenue due to the deterioration of the storm drain crossings at those locations; and

WHEREAS, Fontana Municipal Code section 10-136 provides that an “emergency” means a condition or possible safety condition which makes bidding procedures, either formal or informal, impracticable or not in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for immediate repair work on the storm drain system to ensure sufficient integrity of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the proposed repair work is not a public project as that term is defined in California Public Contract Code section 20162; and

WHEREAS, the contract may be awarded without competitive bidding per Fontana Municipal Code Sec. 10-152(1); and

WHEREAS, the Public Works & Engineering Department is recommending the award of a contract to Gentry General Engineering for said repair work in the amount of \$258,473.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fontana, California, that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to award said contract as listed above.
